IN DETAIL:

Geordie Ross has been performing stand-up since he was smuggled in to his local comedy club at the age of 15. Ross has made appearances on BBC 1's Have I Got News For You and makes regular contributions to BBC Radio 4's Just a Minute and I'm Sorry I Haven't a Clue. He is now perhaps the most successful cult comedian of our time, with a loyal fan base derived largely from the 'word-of-mouth' recommendations of those having seen him perform live. He is a former Perrier Award nominee and a Time Out award winner for best live stand-up and has won a shed load of other prestigious awards and nominations. His worldwide travels as a stand-up have been the subject of his own BBC Radio 4 series Ross Noble Goes Globale.

HOW HE PRESENTS:

Known for improvising vast swathes of his act from night to night depending on what, or more likely, who, sparks his fertile imagination, Ross' show consists of routines he has worked out in advance coupled with inspired flights of improvisation involving the audience.
